Letlotlo is a private school that caters for Pre-Primary, Lower Primary and Higher Primary and Secondary Education.

- Sekolo se kena ka 7:00 a.m. Students arrive at 7:00 a.m. (subject to change)
- Ngoana e mong le e mong oa sekolo o lebelletsoe a be a le morning assembly ka 7:30 a.m. Ho sebelisoa li tablets ho ithuta lentsoe la Molimo le ho bina lifela. Students are expected to be at the morning assembly at 7:30 a.m. Tablets shall be used for morning devotion at the morning assembly.
- Motsoali ke eena a tlalehelang class teacher kapa principal haeba ngoana a sa atlehe ho tla sekolong. A parent should report absenteeism to the class teacher or the principal
- Ngoana o tla lokolleloa motsoali oa hae fela kapa moikarabelli. Motsoali o lokela ho etsa tlhophiso e hlakileng ea ho tlalehela sekolo haeba ngoana a sa tlo latoa ke motsoali kapa moikarabelli. Learners will be not be taken from school by none other than the parents or guardian. Otherwise a special arrangement should be made.

Fees

- Registration is once off and non-refundable
- Fees are divided into four quarters (first, second, third and fourth quarter)
- Quarterly fees should be paid in full at the beginning of every quarter
- All the figures are in Lesotho and South African currencies

CODE OF CONDUCT

- a. Bana bohle le litichere tsohle ke masupatsela. Bohle ba lebeletsoe ho nka karalo bosupa-tseleng. All students and teachers are pathfinders. Everyone is expected to take part in pathfinder activities.
- b. Bana bohle ba tlameha ho apara seaparo sa sekolo ka nepo kamehla. All the students are supposed to put on the proper school uniform.
- c. Bana bohle ba lokela ho tla ba hloekile sekolong kamehla. All the students are supposed to come to school neat and tidy.

- d. Bashanyana ba lokela ho kuta moriri ka makhethe. Boys are expected to cut their hair neatly.
- e. Banana ba lokela ho boloka lihlooho tsa bona li hloekile kamehla, meriri e melelele e tlangoe kapa ba e lohe kamor'a libeke tse ling le tse ling tse peli hoseng joalo moriri o kutoe. Girls are expected to keep their hair neat and tidy. Girls are expected to renew their hairstyle fortnightly, otherwise the hair should be cut. The following hairstyles are permitted
- Essence –should be braided straight or puff style ONLY.
 - Braiding- should be braided straight or puff style with color ONE hairpiece ONLY.
 - Natural dread- should be braided straight or puff style ONLY.
 - Knotless braids should be braided to the end of the strands with color ONE hair piece only.
 - Long hair must be tied back or up.
 - Girls cut is allowed but it must not be curled.
 - Natural short hair.

NOTE: All braids must be braided with color one hair piece only. no any other hair style is allowed except the ones mentioned above.

- f. Banana kapa bashanyana ha ba roale masale litsebeng kapa menoaneng. Students are not all to put on earrings and rings.
- g. Litelu ha lia lumelloa. No student is allowed to keep beards.
- h. Bokhachane sekolong ha bo ea lumelloa. Ngoana eo e tlaaba mokhachane o tla lula hae. Pregnancy is strictly prohibited. Pregnant girls must be kept at home.
- i. Molao oa sekolo ke hore thepa engoe le engoe e senyehileng motho a e sentseng o nka boikarabello ba ho e lokisa. Vandalism is not tolerated at all, anyone who vandalizes the school property shall take the responsibility to repair it. **(you break you pay).**
- j. **Ngoana ea utsoang thepa ea ba bang o tebeloa hang hang.** A child who steals other pupil's property shall be expelled with immediate effect.

- k. Chelete,lijo ,drink ha lia lumelloa. Bana ha ba ea lumelloa ho reka ha ba apere seaparo sa sekolo. Money, food and drinks are not allowed at school. Students are not allowed to buy when they are on their school uniform.
- l. Bana ha ba ea lumelloa ho tla ka lijo, ba lumelloa ho tla ka li fruits feela. Students are only allowed to come with fruits.
- m. Ha ho bana ba lumeletsoeng ho hlorisa ba bang kapa ho ba hobosa ka libopeho tsa bona. Bullying is not allowed in any form. Decisive measures shall be taken against such.
- n. Bana ba lokela ho bua sekhoaa kamehla ha ba apere seaparo sa sekolo. le hae. The official means of communication is English. Labohlano ke letsatsi la lerato la naha, bana ba lumelletsoe ho bua Sesotho le litichere li lumelletsoe ho ruta ka Sesotho. Friday is the day marked for patriotism. Learners are allowed to speak in Sesotho and teachers are allowed to teach in Sesotho.
- o. **cell phone** ha li ea lumelloa. Personal cell phones are not allowed. Cell phones that come to school should be allowed by authority and follow rules that govern gadgets.
- p. Litlhapa ha li ea lumelloa. Vulgar language is strictly prohibited.
